Amendments in Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Sub: Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013. Sir,

I am directed to say that the Board of Governors in its meeting held on 26.9.2018 reconsidered its proposal made in its third meeting (24.7.2018), in the matter of amendment in Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013 for incorporating the provisions of Section 12(C) of Homoeopathy Central Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2018 and decided to circulate the following under Section 20 (2) of HCC Act, 1973-

> "The sub-regulation (4) to (9) of regulation 3 of Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013, may be substituted with the following:

The existing colleges and their attached hospitals which were established or opened for a new or higher course of study or training or increased the admission capacity under section 12A of the Act and those colleges and their hospitals established prior to the 28th January, 2003 and recognized by Central Council of Homoeopathy shall seek permission of the Central Government before 17th May, 2019 in accordance with the provisions specified in Homoeopathy Central Council (Permission to Existing Homoeopathic Medical Colleges) Regulations, 2018.

If any college fails to seek permission under the sub-regulation 3(4)(a), the provisions of section 12B of the Act shall be applicable and shall be treated as if the permission of Central Government has been refused." Whales

The Board of Governors discussed about the requirement of 'specified provisions' for making Applications by the existing Homoeopathic Colleges under Section 12 C of HCC Act and considered the draft (new) Regulations as recommended by the Executive Committee of BoG namely Homoeopathy Central Council (Permission to Existing Homoeopathic Medical Colleges) Regulations, 2018, and after threadbare discussion on it, BoG finalized the same. The BoG directed the office to circulate the proposed new Regulations (Annexure-A) and also the above proposed amendment in regulation 3 (4) to 3 (9) of Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013 under Section 20 (2) of HCC Act, 1973.

It is therefore, requested to all State/U.T. Govts. to send their comments on said proposed amendments in Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013 to this Council within three months from the date of its issue as per provisions of Section 20(2) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973.

- In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 33 of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 (59 of 1973), the Central Council of Homoeopathy, with the previous sanction of the Central Government, makes the following regulations, namely:-

- 1. Short Title and commencement :-
 - (i) These regulations may be called the Homoeopathy Central Council (Permission to Existing Medical Colleges) Regulations, 2018.
 - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in (the Official Gazette.
- 2. Definitions .-
 - (i) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,
 - a) "Act" means the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973.
 - b) "Existing Homoeopathic Medical College" means a Medical College of Homoeopathy established on or before 17th day of May 2018, whether known as such or by any other name, in which a person undergoes a course of study and training at Under Graduate or Post Graduate level, which will qualify him for the award of a recognized medical qualification in Homoeopathy.
 - c) "Section" means a Section of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973; and
 - d) "Form" means a Form annexed to these regulations.
 - (ii) Words and expressions used herein and not defined but defined in the Act shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973.
 - 3. Permission to be obtained by an existing Homoeopathic Medical College.-

The existing colleges and their attached hospitals which were established or opened for a new or higher course of study or training or increasing the admission capacity under section 12A of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and those colleges and their hospitals established prior to the 28th January, 2003 and recognized by Central Council of Homoeopathy shall submit an application in Form-1, to the Central Government on or before 17th May, 2019, in accordance with the provisions specified in these regulations.

4. Authority to whom the applications are to be submitted.-

(i) Applications under regulation 3 shall be submitted to the Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy (AYUSH).

(ii) Applications which are incomplete shall not be accepted.

5. Eligibility for making an application-

(i) A person or an existing Homoeopathic medical college shall be eligible for making an application under regulation 3 if-

a) the Homoeopathic medical college and its attached hospital are suitably located preferably in a single plot, but which may consist of two plots reasonably close (not more than two kilometer) to each other on land which is owned by the applicant or has been taken on lease at least for a period of thirty years of which atleast 5 years of lease should be subsisting at the time of making application;

b) permission of the concerned State Government has been obtained at the time of establishment of the Homoeopathic Medical College and the permission continues;

 affiliation from a University established under any Central or State Act has been obtained for running the Degree/Post Graduate Degree Course(s) in Homoeopathy and the affiliation continues;

d) the applicant owns and manages a fully functional homoeopathy hospital with a minimum number of beds as prescribed in Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirements of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013, which conforms to the norm and standards relating to minimum bed strength and bed occupancy for in-patients and to the number of out-patients for undergraduate and Post Graduate Course(s) in Homoeopathy as the case may be;

e) the homoeopathic medical college has appointed the teaching, non-teaching and Hospital staff as specified in the Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirements of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013;

f) the homoeopathic college and attached homoeopathic hospital conforms to the other minimum standards of education as may be specified in the Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirements of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013. 6. Fee to be submitted along with the application— The application to be submitted under regulation 3 shall be accompanied by a fee of Rupees two lakhs (non refundable) in the form of a demand draft/pay order in favour of "Central Council of Homoeopathy" payable at New Delhi.

7. Recommendation of the Central Council-

On receipt of the application from the Central Government, the Central Council shall examine it suitably and conduct an inspection of the Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital to verify whether the provisions of the Act and the relevant Regulations made there-under have been fulfilled and then submit the recommendations of the Executive Committee of the Council in Form- 2 to the Central Government.

8. Issue of Letter of Permission.-

The Central Government may/after considering the recommendations of the Central Council and on being satisfied that the application is in order, issue a letter of permission. In the event, the Central Government is come to the conclusion that the applicant college is not fit to be continued, order of denial shall be passed after giving reasonable opportunity of being heard to the applicant.

9. Failure to seek permission-

The provisions of section 12B will apply to homoeopathic medical colleges which fail to seek permission within the time schedule laid down in these regulations.

10. Time schedule for processing-

The time schedule for the processing of cases will be notified by the Central Government.
